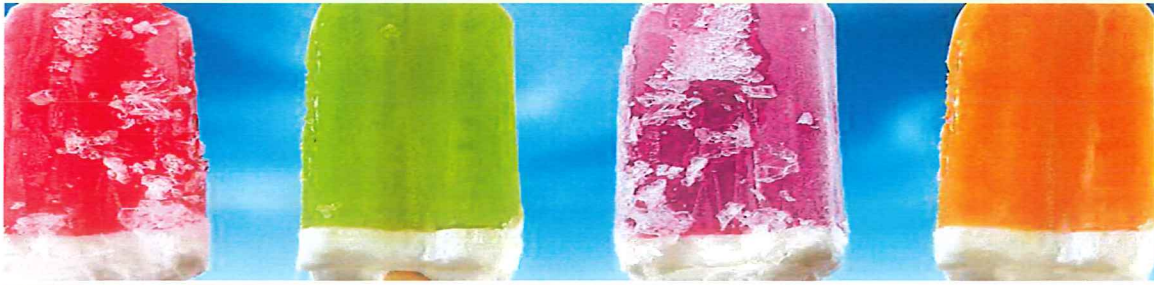

A Word from our CEO...

Since our last newsletter the construction project has progressed at a rapid pace. Of course, weather still plays a factor on some days but now that the interior is enclosed the construction workers are busy from morning to night. We already had our 50% completion inspection from the Fire Marshall and successfully passed. In the interior drywall is nearing completion and tiling is slated to begin. The mechanical room has the majority of the equipment installed and other equipment such as headboards have been installed in the rooms. Outside the building they are preparing for concrete to be poured soon for the parking lots and are beginning to work on the storage building. Roof top units are set and windows should be next on the list for installation. It is amazing to see the progress that has occurred over the past several months. The project remains on budget and on schedule with the estimated completion date of late January 2020. Remember you can view the live web camera 24/7 on our website to see the progress for yourself.

Other exciting news is the addition of Dr. Barbara Brown as an employee of OCMH/Goad Clinic effective 08/01/2019. She will be joining Alison Begay, FNP-C, and Joshua Choate, PA-C, in practice at the Goad Clinic and providing on-call coverage in the Emergency Department. We are still recruiting for another fulltime physician to replace the position of Dr. Erin Baxa who is leaving on 08/07/2019 to continue her medical career in Kingman, KS.

The availability for health care for the future in Osborne County looks very promising and we continue to research options to offer more services once the new facility is constructed. Currently, we are exploring options for additional specialty clinics, cardiac rehabilitation, pulmonary rehabilitation and offering a wellness center on a limited basis after business hours. OCMH appreciates the continued support of the employees, patients and residents of Osborne County to allow us to provide health care services.

DO YOU NEED A SCHOOL SPORTS PHYSICAL?

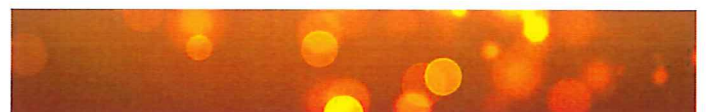
